**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN  
THE COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA AND MEDICINES AUSTRALIA**

I am delighted that we have reached agreement on a range of matters that promote the long-term sustainability of the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS).

The attached Memorandum of Understanding details the commitments made by the Commonwealth of Australia and Medicines Australia until 30 June 2014.
